

ADENE Cream (Adapalene 0.1%)

Composition:

Each gram contains:

Adapalene 0.1% w/w

Adapalene is used to treat acne. Adapalene is in a class of medications called retinoid-like compounds. It works by stopping pimples from forming under the surface of the skin.

INDICATIONS

ADENE Cream 0.1% is indicated for the topical treatment of acne vulgaris in patients 12 years of age and older.

Contraindications:

Adapalene is contraindicated in conditions like Eczema, Cancer, Hypersensitivity.

DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION

Apply a thin film of **ADENE Cream 0.1%** to the entire face and any other affected areas of the skin once daily avoiding eyes, lips, and mucous membranes, after washing gently with a non-medicated soap. A mild transitory sensation of warmth or slight stinging may occur shortly after the application of **ADENE Cream 0.1%**. Patients should be instructed to minimize sun exposure. Patients may be instructed to use moisturizers for relief of dry skin or irritation.

If therapeutic results are not noticed after 12 weeks of treatment, therapy should be re-evaluated. For topical use only. Not for ophthalmic, oral or intravaginal use.

SIDE EFFECTS

Some adverse effects such as erythema, scaling, dryness, pruritus, and burning will occur in 10-40% of patients. Pruritus or burning immediately after application also occurs in approximately 20% of patients. The following additional adverse experiences were reported in approximately 1% or less of patients: skin irritation, burning/stinging, erythema, sunburn, and acne flares. These are most commonly seen during the first month of therapy and decrease in frequency and severity thereafter. All adverse effects with use of **ADENE (adapalene cream) Cream** during clinical trials were reversible upon discontinuation of therapy.

DRUG INTERACTIONS

As **Adene (adapalene) Cream** has the potential to produce local irritation in some patients, concomitant use of other potentially irritating topical products (medicated or abrasive soaps and cleansers, soaps and cosmetics that have a strong drying effect, and products with high concentrations of alcohol, astringents, spices, or lime) should be approached with caution. Particular caution should be exercised in using preparations containing sulfur, resorcinol, or salicylic acid in combination with **ADENE (adapalene cream) Cream**. If these preparations have been used, it is advisable not to start therapy with **Adene (adapalene cream) Cream** until the effects of such preparations in the skin have subsided.

Availability and Storage:

Adene Cream is available as 0.1% w/w cream in 15 gm and 45gm packings.

Store below 30°C in a dry and dark place.
